VILLAGE OF LAKE ORION -South BELLEVUE Section

Water Main Replacement to start August 19

The Village of Lake Orion is notifying you that scheduled to begin the week **August 19 for S. Bellevue**, weather permitting, the Village's contractor, **Fontana Construction, Inc.** will continue the water main replacement project on several streets throughout the Village, including your street, **S. Bellevue from the bridge south to Unger Park.** and adjoining streets, which will continue and be completed by **September 15, 2019**, or sooner weather permitting. **This section of Bellevue section will begin next week August 19.** Please see the full project map on the back of this flyer. Property Owners will receive additional flyers noting important project updates throughout the duration of the project. The Village will also provide periodic project updates on their website www.lakeorion.org and the Lake Orion Police Department Facebook page.

Prior to the start of actual construction, the water main location will be marked by placement of offset stakes. You will also see colored flags being placed by the various utility companies marking their facilities. Various trenchless technologies, such as directional drilling and pipe bursting, will primarily be used for the pipe installation which will limit the surface disruption to those areas where access pits (at valve and hydrant locations) and water service reconnections are proposed. A temporary water system will be installed on the ground surface with 1" water services connected directly to each property's outside hose bib/spigot or to the existing water service for a period of approximately three (3) weeks that will be protected by aggregate at each driveway and street crossing. The temporary water system will be protected by stone at each driveway and street crossing. **The Village requests that homeowners refrain from watering their lawn during the A.M. and P.M. peak hours of the day (7-10 A.M. and 3-7 P.M.) while temporary water service is being provided.**

Your water supply is expected to be interrupted for a minimum of one (1) working day at a time while the contractor is working in your area. You will be given advance notice of the scheduled shut-down(s). In order to prepare as best as possible for the loss of water on this day, the Village suggests that residents store drinking water in the refrigerator and disposable water in the bath tub. All disturbed areas will be promptly restored upon completion of the water main installation. If you notice that your water is murky, brown/red in color, and 'sputters' out of the faucets during the project, this is normal and the best thing you can do would be to flush only the cold water side of the lowest system point in the house until the water runs clear and preferably from the location with the shortest run to the water service intake (e.g. laundry tub or an outside spigot). All disturbed areas will be promptly restored upon completion of the water main installation.

Local traffic is expected to be maintained at all times during construction with the exception of possible minor interruptions. **However, on-street parking will not be allowed during construction on your street.** Residents will be notified prior to any temporary interruption in access to their driveways. Please obey the posted construction signs, and observe and respect the work crews in the area during construction. Every effort will be made to minimize any inconvenience to all area property owners. Your patience and cooperation is appreciated during this time. 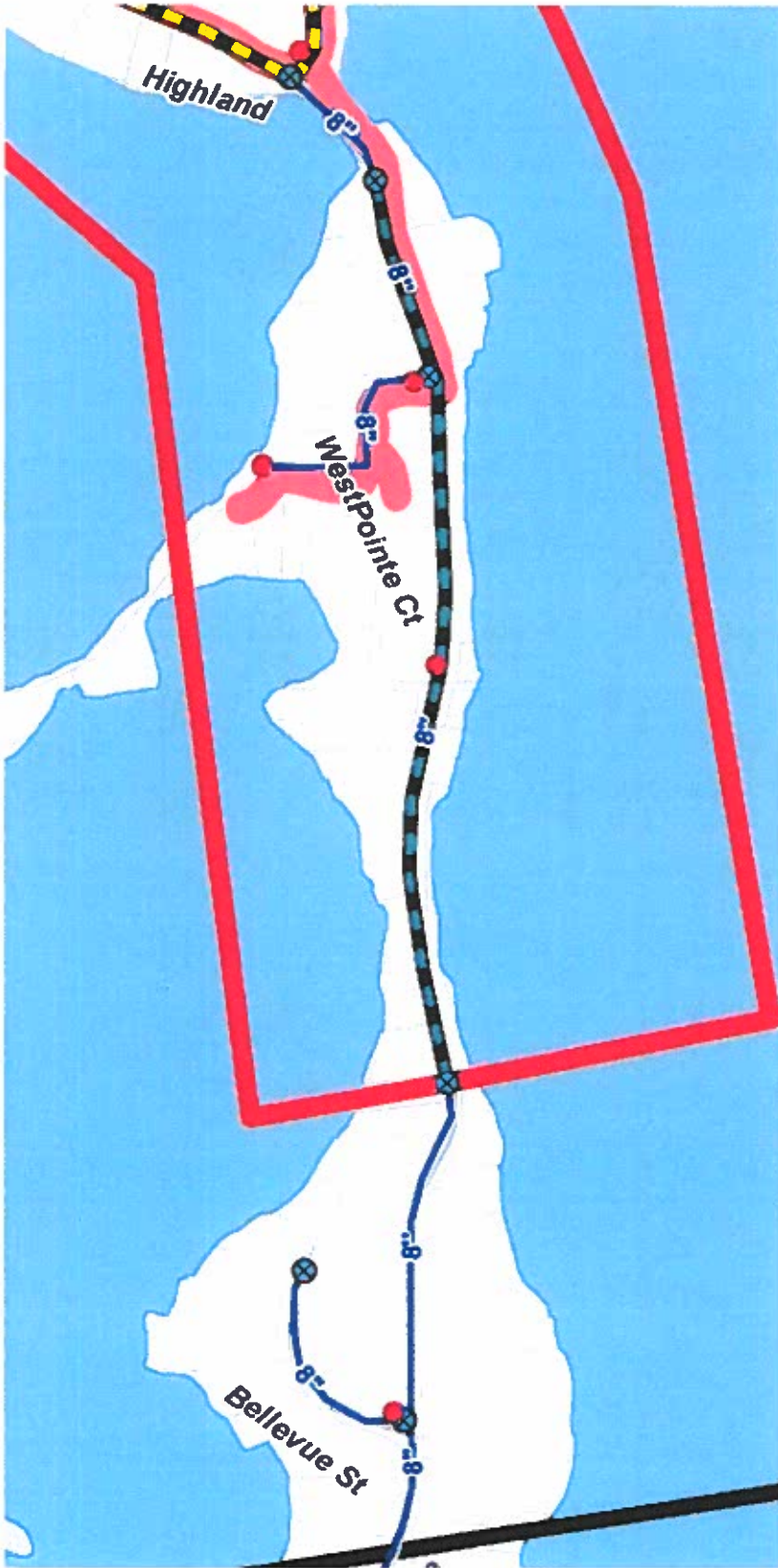
