Register with our "Vacation Property Inspection" program.

The Lake Orion Police Department has a program to assist our residents by providing extra home patrols and inspections while you are away on vacation, business or while residing in another state or location during seasonal residency. Let's face it, less stress means more fun and greater peace of mind.

LOPD Officers will provide non-routine extra patrol and inspections to vacant home or property to assist in preventing human and natural dangers, and to provide early notice in the event your home has suffered storm damage, or other hazardous conditions where early discovery will assist in mitigating greater damage or loss. We will notify you and / or a person of your choosing if anything is discovered and assist you in getting emergency home repair services coming to resolve a problem quickly.

There is no fee, just a simple form to complete, the information is private and secure, and is deleted when you return from your vacancy. Complete the attached form and email it to:
